The King James Version of this week's memory verse says, "And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, 'All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.' " Matthew 28:18 KJV

Jesus spoke these words to His disciples after he had shed His blood, died, and was buried; and after He had defeated death by rising from the dead. There was no hesitation, no stammering, and no question. Death and the power of sin had, once and for all time, been defeated. What centuries of sacrificed bulls, goats, and lambs could not achieve Jesus Christ provided by His death, His burial, and His resurrection.

The veil in the Temple, that had separated the common man from the presence of God, had been torn from top to bottom. (Mat 27:51) No longer was mankind required to go through the high priest. Now everyone had access to the very presence and power of the Almighty God.

Just prior to His ascension into heaven, the risen Jesus makes promise to His followers: "You shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you." (Acts 1:8) Men and women were going to have the opportunity to have the Holy Spirit of God living and active inside of them.

And, the important key is this: it's not just for those in the Book of Acts. "For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call." –Act 2:39 NKJV
