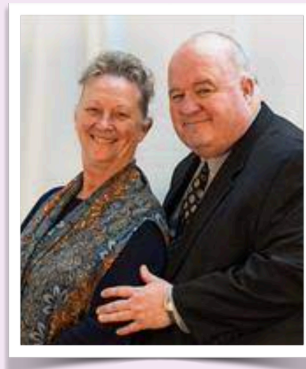
Monday Missions

As a teenager, Bryan Abernathy went to Africa with his missionary parents, Charles and Janet Abernathy. After graduating from the Bible college in Cape Town, South Africa, he remained there until 1982 when he returned to the States to evangelize.

Brother Abernathy pastored in Florida and Indiana for over twenty years. Among other positions, he also served as Global Missions director for the Indiana District.

As result of his deep-rooted burden for missions, in 2004, Brother Abernathy was appointed as the Director of Promotion for Global Missions. He continue to minister in this capacity today,
